

Our Vision





For a state as small as Burgenland, in the centre of Europe, looking beyond the borders has always been important and this is clearly reflected in our strategy. We offer our students, lecturers, researchers and staff an international, intercultural working environment through a network of partner institutes and several companies abroad. Thus intercultural courses and language courses taught by native speakers play a key role. It is also possible for students to go abroad to take part in summer camps, to join study groups

and to take language courses. Internships and a semester spent elsewhere in Europe also offer the opportunity to add international networking and improved language skills to the CV. This process of internationalisation is supported by various fellowship programs such as the ERASMUS programme, bilateral programmes such as CEEPUS (Central and Eastern European countries) and national funding programmes.

Business Studies

(focusing on Central and Eastern Europe)

We train leaders of the future to shape the future. A particular feature of our courses is the focus on Central and Eastern Europe. Our students learn the languages, economies and cultures of Eastern European countries as well as economic theory which will later boost their CVs and ultimately their employability.

Information Technology and Information Management

"Information" is the heart of this department, which provides future-oriented degree programmes that focus on the organisation of information and knowledge, IT infrastructure management, online marketing and communication, mobility and interconnectedness in the Cloud or the design of business processes from both an economic and technical point of view. Cooperation with business partners and acquiring practical experience are key elements in all of the programmes.

Social Work

The Department of Social Care gives undergraduate students the opportunity to combine social work and social science subjects. The main focus in this degree programme is on developing both methodological and hands-on competencies. Students are offered a wide range of character building activities and practical experience to help them on their way. There is a unique emphasis on child, youth and family welfare.
