## Pinkafeld: Town in the South

Nestled in the southwest of Burgenland, Pinkafeld is located only a few kilometres from the borders of Lower Austria, Styria and Burgenland. The landscape is characterised by rolling hills and the foothills of the Wechsel massif. Pinkafeld is a young, vibrant university town which offers a wide range of leisure activities. In the middle of Burgenland's thermal spa region, students will enjoy the quality of life there and the personal atmosphere on the campus.





## Eisenstadt: City of Culture

Eisenstadt is Austria's smallest federal state capital. It was once one of the Esterházy royal capitals and has much to offer, including late Gothic arcades, Baroque facades, the Esterházy castle, the beautiful St. Martin's Cathedral and the heritage-protected old town. Just 20 minutes from Eisenstadt, students will find yet another reason why studying here is so enjoyable, namely the recreation and conservation area around Lake Neusiedl, Europe's largest steppe lake.

### Department of Business Studies

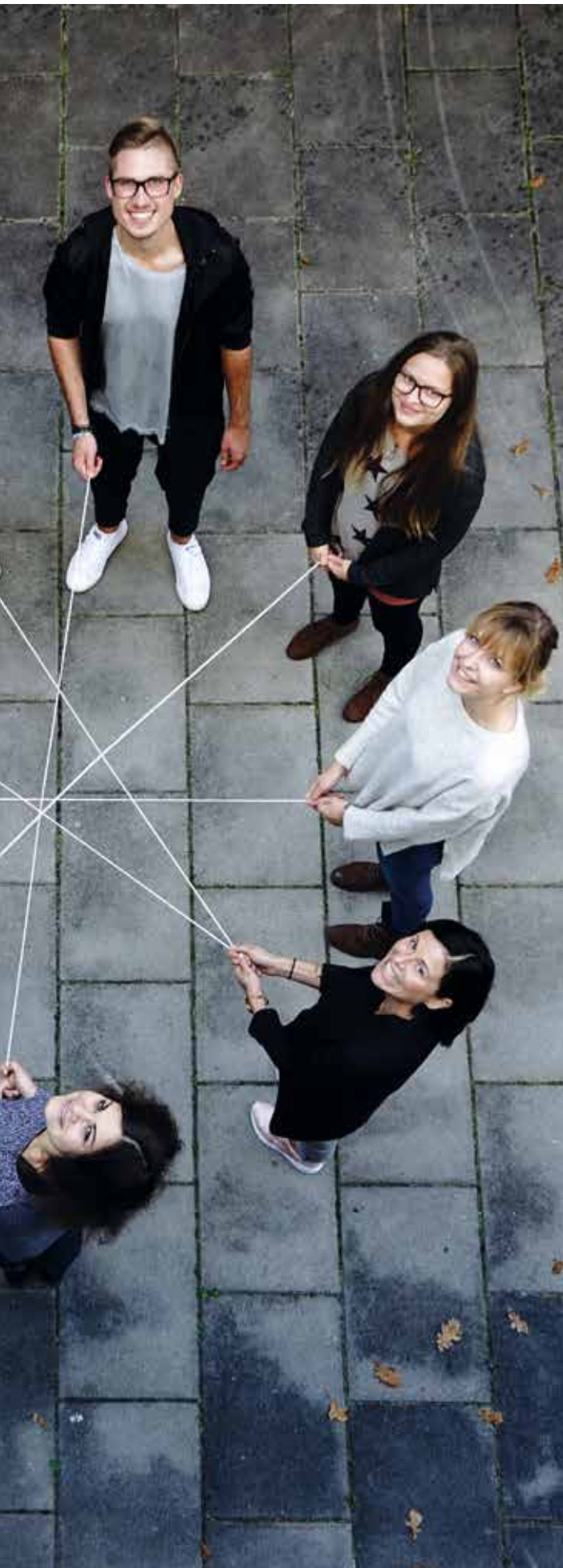
### Department of Information Technology

“Information“ lies at the heart of this department. The future-oriented study programmes focus on information and knowledge organization, IT infrastructure management, online marketing and online communication, mobility and networking in the cloud or the design of business processes from an economic and technical point of view. Cooperation with business partners, innovation and a lot of practice are particularly important.

### Department of Social Work

The Department of Social Work gives under-graduate students the opportunity to combine social work and social science subjects. The main focus in this degree programme is on developing both methodological and hands-on competencies. Students are offered a wide range of character building activities and practical experience to help them on their way. There is a unique emphasis on child, youth and family welfare.





## Department of Energy & Environment

A degree in Energy & Environment stands for a sound technical education combined with economic and legal management aspects. Students can actively participate in top-class research and development – especially in the fields of energy and environmental management, energy and environmental technology, sustainable energy systems, as well as building technology, automation, management, electronics and photonics.

## Department of Health

In the Department of Health, future-oriented Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes offer scientifically sound, practice-oriented vocational training. The focus is the promotion of health, health and health care management as well as care, midwifery and physiotherapy. In all programmes, the teaching of subject-related, methodological, social and occupational competencies is a top priority.

The University of Applied Sciences Burgenland is 100% owned by Landesholding Burgenland, a 100% company of the State of Burgenland.

With three subsidiaries, the UAS Burgenland is involved in promoting research, continuous academic education and professional qualifications in the public sector.

The association „alumni FH Burgenland“ is responsible for networking with and among graduates.

### Forschung Burgenland – the research subsidiary

The UAS Burgenland (75,1%) and Economic Agency Burgenland (24,9%) subsidiary is dedicated exclusively to research and development. The spectrum of research activities ranges from large international projects to pin-pointed contract research carried out for SMEs and the industry.

At the Pinkafeld site, experienced scientists conduct research projects with high innovation potential and involve students, who benefit from a high-tech energy and environmental technology laboratory and a health laboratory.

The „living lab“ Energetikum is „state of the art“ in terms of energy and building technology.

At the Eisenstadt location, eye-tracking and IT-labs are available for innovative market research studies or research regarding e-communications, e-learning, media, knowledge management, IT-security and smart computing.

## AIM – MBA Courses

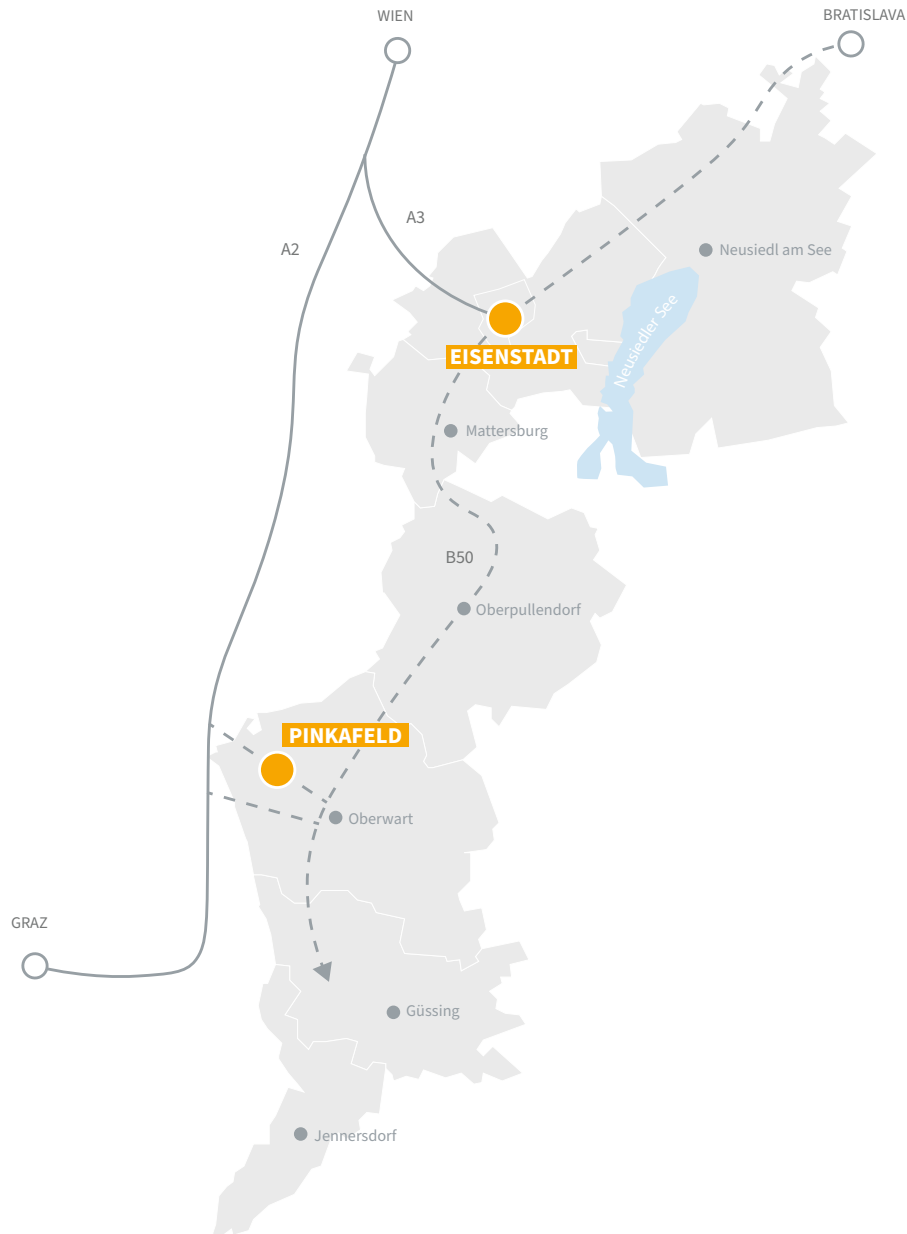
