

Target Groups and Entry Requirements

Two tracks are available depending on the language skills.

Bridging Programme:

2 years (4 semesters) for those with language skills at AI level in German and English A2.

Advanced Bridging Programme:

I year (2 semesters) for those with language skills at BI level both in German and English.
