International Joint Cross-Border PhD Programme in International Economic Relations and Management

Our partner universities are high-ranking, nationally and internationally accredited foreign universities that are authorised to award doctoral and postgraduate degrees as well as post-doctoral qualifications.

The joint PhD programme as an interdisciplinary, cross-border, international science and research-oriented PhD programme is innovative in terms of structure and organisation comparable to the best cross-border PhD programmes within the EU. It takes into account the requirements of small groups of doctoral students, sound basic knowledge with a variety of specialisations and enables students to work closely with supervisors in their respective, broad-based subject areas at foreign universities.

PhD-candidates have the opportunity to develop thorough fundamental knowledge in a variety of specializations, allowing students to work with supervisors within their respective areas of expertise at the respective partner universities abroad.

Target Groups and Entry Requirements

The International Joint Cross-Border PhD Programme addresses candidates in qualified professional positions, preferably with backgrounds in business management or economics who wish to obtain a doctoral degree based on advanced applied research.

The International Joint Cross-Border PhD Programme is open to applicants who

- hold a Diploma or Master's degree (5 years) or equivalent degree issued by an officially accredited university or institution of higher education
- submit complete application documents including a statement of personal motivation and a description of the intended research orientation;
- have at least two years of qualified professional experience
- master English on at least C1-level
- and successfully pass the admission process.

Highlights

- part-time studies to be completed within a minimum of 3 years (6 semesters, 180 ECTS); to complete the doctoral dissertation a student may take up to six years from the date the Consortium accepts the research proposal
- language of tuition: English
- professors are renowned and distinguished academics and professionals of highly acclaimed universities
- individual and group tutorial face2face sessions
- international research cooperations

Academic Degree

After the successful completion of all exams and academic requirements, doctoral students are awarded the internationally recognized highest academic degree on behalf of all partner universities within the Consortium.

The International Joint Cross-Border PhD programme in International Economic Relations and Management was submitted to the Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation Austria (AQ) in accordance with § 27 para. 1 and registered by the AQ in accordance with § 27 para. 6 HS-QSG. The registration of the programme in accordance with § 27 para. 6 HS-QSG does not ascertain equivalence with Austrian study programmes and similar Austrian academic degrees. Graduates awarded an academic degree are entitled to use it in accordance with § 88 para. 1 of the 2002 law governing universities. The academic degrees in International Economic Relations and Management in the International Joint Cross-Border PhD programme jointly awarded by the participating universities of economics in Bratislava, Sopron, Pula, Varaždin, Mostar and Prague are therefore recognized foreign degrees in Austria and may be used in official documents in accordance with § 88 para. 1a of the 2002 law governing universities.

The International Joint Cross-Border PhD Programme in International Relations and Management is a unique cross-border doctoral programme, set up in co-operation with Central European Universities. At the time of publication, the partner institutions are the University of Bratislava, the University of Sopron, the University of Pula, the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague, the University of Mostar and the University North, Varaždin. The programme is comparable to leading cross-border doctoral programmes within the EU in terms of structure and organisation. On behalf of all partner universities the International Economic Joint Cross-Border PhD Programme in International Relations and Management is organized and administered by the Consortium of the partner universities in collaboration with the University of Applied Sciences Burgenland (UAS Burgenland), Eisenstadt, Austria. All partner universities are long-established, state-run universities entitled to award doctoral and post-doctoral degrees and qualifications.

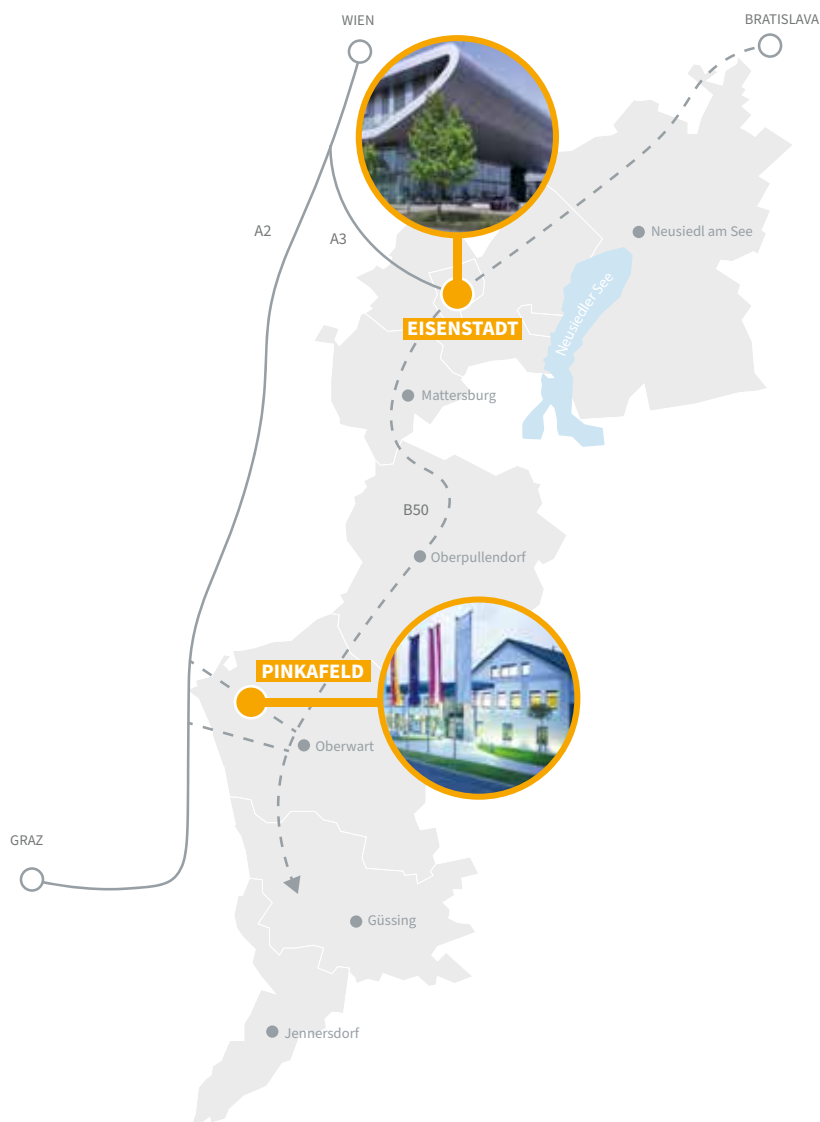
The Campus in Eisenstadt
